



SECURITRE Version 3.3.1 Release Notes July 2006

Treehouse Software is pleased to announce the release of SECURITRE Version 3.3.1.

Note: This release of SECURITRE supports NATURAL version 3.1.6 and above only.

This is the last release of SECURITRE that will support NATURAL version 3.1.6.

SECURITRE no longer supports CICS versions prior to 3.2. All versions of CICS Transaction Server (CICSTS) are supported.

Note: New modules, TSIRDC31, TSIRDC41, and TSIRDC42 are supplied with this release and must be used instead of TSIRDC when linking NATURAL. Refer to **Section IX.6.6 Link-edit a NATURAL Nucleus** of the SECURITRE Administrator manual for instructions on linking NATURAL.

Enhancements

- NATURAL 4.2 support
- The zap status of SECURITRE Utility Security and SECURITRE's User-Exit-1 is now printed to the STRMSG DD if STRMSG is specified in the job.

SECURITRE Zaps And Fixes

- A five digit DBID was incorrectly used when performing RTM security checks and the DBID was less than 255. Reference 1-4237
- The RTM main menu displayed the incorrect version.
- SECURITRE incorrectly allocated buffer space below the 16MB line when it should allocate it above the line. Reference 1-4305
- Group-ID is not obtained or used under COM-LETE. Reference 1-4387
- S013 abends occurred with SECURITRE Utility Security installed. Reference 1-4244
- STRNAT did not properly recognize a version 7 database. Reference 1-4400
- The error message 'INVALID FILE NUMBER > 255' incorrectly displayed when SECURITRE Utility Security is installed. Reference 1-4428
- The RTM incorrectly displayed 'EX1ALL=OFF' when it was set to ON in the STRDEF parameters. Reference 1-4526
- File number is "XXXXX" when SECURITRE's Exit B is not installed or not called. Reference 1-4581.

- SECURITRE was unable to load the parameters when installed with ADABAS 7.1.3. Reference 1-4680.
- Various abends occurred and/or NATURAL information was not obtained correctly. Reference 1-4240
- The error 'INVALUD UTILITY FUNCTION' was encountered when an optional parameter was included on the same line as the required function. Reference 1-4852
- The default was changed to no logging when the ADABAS CQE or UINFO area are not available. Reference 1-5053.
- A S0C4 abend occurred when ADABAS Stored Triggers and Procedures (STP) are used. Reference 1-5275.

Expiration Date /Authorization Zap

SECURITRE is distributed as an "Expired Trial". Sites installing SECURITRE must apply an Authorization Zap for "sold" status or an Expiration Zap for "trial" status. The same sold or trial zap used for Version 3.2 may be used for 3.3. If further instructions are necessary, please contact support@treehouse.com.

SECURITRE For NATURAL Users

New modules have been added to support NATURAL 4.2. When linking NATURAL, the modules beginning with STN42 must be used. Refer to section IX.6.6 Link-edit a NATURAL Nucleus of the SECURITRE Administrator Manual for details on linking the NATURAL nucleus.
